NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (WTRO4585) affecting the **1)** Norwich Road from its junction with Marham Road for 50m eastwards and 50m westwards; and **2)** Marham Road from its junction with Norwich Road for 50m southwards in the PARISH OF FINCHAM to facilitate Norfolk County Council carriageway resurfacing works.

The roads (1) and (2) will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 22nd to 26th January 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 5 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Marham Road, Norwich Road, Shouldham Road, Main Road, Swaffham Road, Chalk Lane, Narborough Road, The Street (Marham, Shouldham, Fincham, Barton Bendish, Beachamwell, Narborough).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
